The Family Specialist will have expertise in areas such as, but limited to: domestic violence, grief and loss, Circle of Security, Kinship, Family Group Conferencing, and possess strong knowledge of community resources.

- Create and develop parenting and child programing for the Tawaw East and West Family Resource Network.
- Complete data entry for new and existing families.
