- Develop a comprehensive fund development strategy that will support the following organizational objectives:
 - Miskanawah to secure a permanent site for Land-based programs and offerings
 - Provide recommendations on people and resources required to facilitate a fundraising campaign for Miskanawah's Land-based healing location
 - Support sustainability planning for Miskanawah's Land stewardship and organizational growth
 - Provide recommendations focused on resource development and sustainability for future fundraising activities, in relation to Land-based healing and all other organizational activities and offerings
 - Involve Miskanawah Elders and community stakeholders in discussions centered on operationalizing Miskanawah's vision for the Land
 - Draw on stakeholder engagement with community partners, donors and sponsors to support collective action and impact
